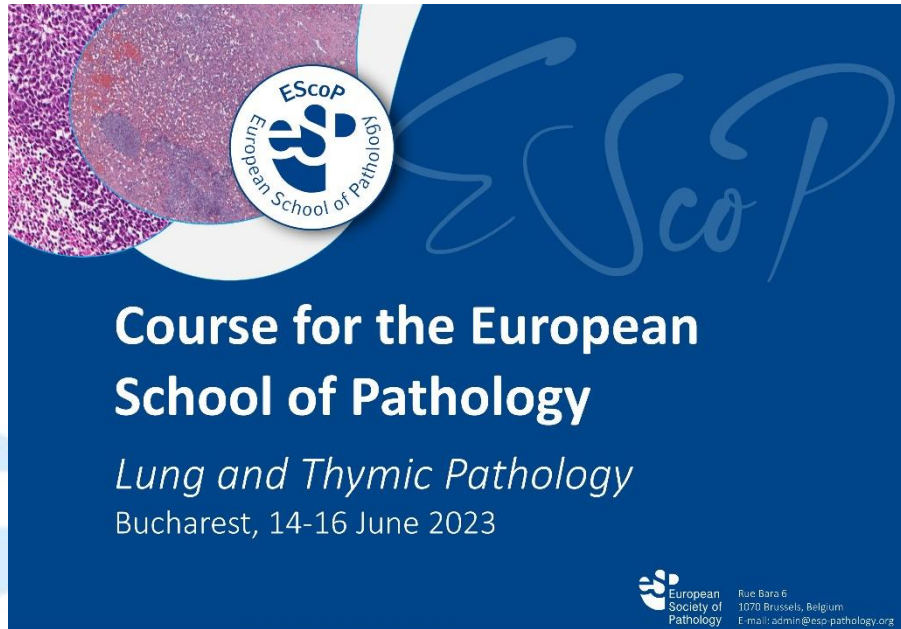


## European School of Pathology (EScOP) course for Lung and Thymic Pathology, Bucharest 2023
